

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR NZAP COUNCIL



Nominations are called for the following positions to be elected to Council.

The following positions will be elected by the membership at the AGM on 13 April 2021:

Honorary Secretary: The Honorary Secretary is elected for a two-year term and can stand for re-election for two further terms of two years.

Catriona Cairns was co-opted into the role of Honorary Secretary as from January 2021, and is standing for election at the AGM. Other nominations are invited.

Honorary Treasurer: The Honorary Treasurer is elected for a two-year term and can stand for re-election for two further terms of two years.

Vicky Blake has completed a two-year term and is stepping down.

Chair of Ethics and Professional Standards Committee: The Chair of the committee is elected for a two-year term and can stand for re-election for two further terms of two years.

Daniel Larsen has completed a two-year term and is stepping down.

Two Ordinary Members of Council: Members of Council are elected for a two-year term and can stand for re-election for two further terms of two years.

Gabriela Mercado has been an Ordinary Member since 2017. She is now taking up the role of President-Elect.

Cindy Smith was elected as an Ordinary Member with the Public Issues portfolio at the 2020 AGM but she has since stepped down.

Nominations for these positions must be in the hands of Catriona Cairns, the Honorary Secretary, by **12 April 2021**, i.e. the day before the AGM.
