

REPORT TO NZAP COUNCIL, OCTOBER 2022

From the Administrator

After a busy period over June and July, emails and queries have slowed down a bit and I have been able to carry on with some projects such as updating documents e.g. Health and Safety planning/ member files, as well as digitising *Forum*.

Membership

We have decreased our membership overall by 11 members. This is the first decrease in membership since 2020. Many of those resigning are doing so as they are fully retired. Others resigned in the process of chasing up late subscription payments. Some feedback was given that members wanted to have a break from the Association in order to evaluate if it was needed.

Scanning Forum

This has been started but is dependent on available time. Forum Volumes 1-5 are now available on the Tuwhera website and a message has been sent out to membership to let them know. 10 Forums to go.
