### Scanning Forum

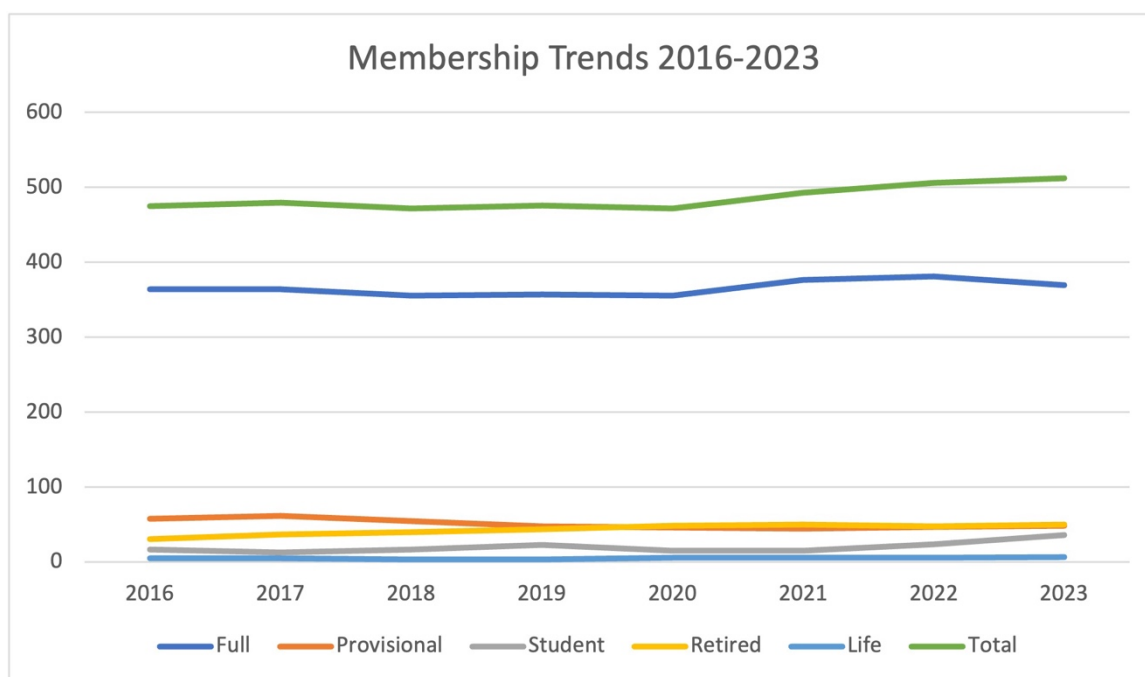
Forum Volumes 1-12 are now available on the Tuwhera website with 3 Forums still to be scanned and uploaded.

An overall increase in 8 members from last September, the biggest increase in the Student membership group with 4 members. This is the largest group of students we have had on record.

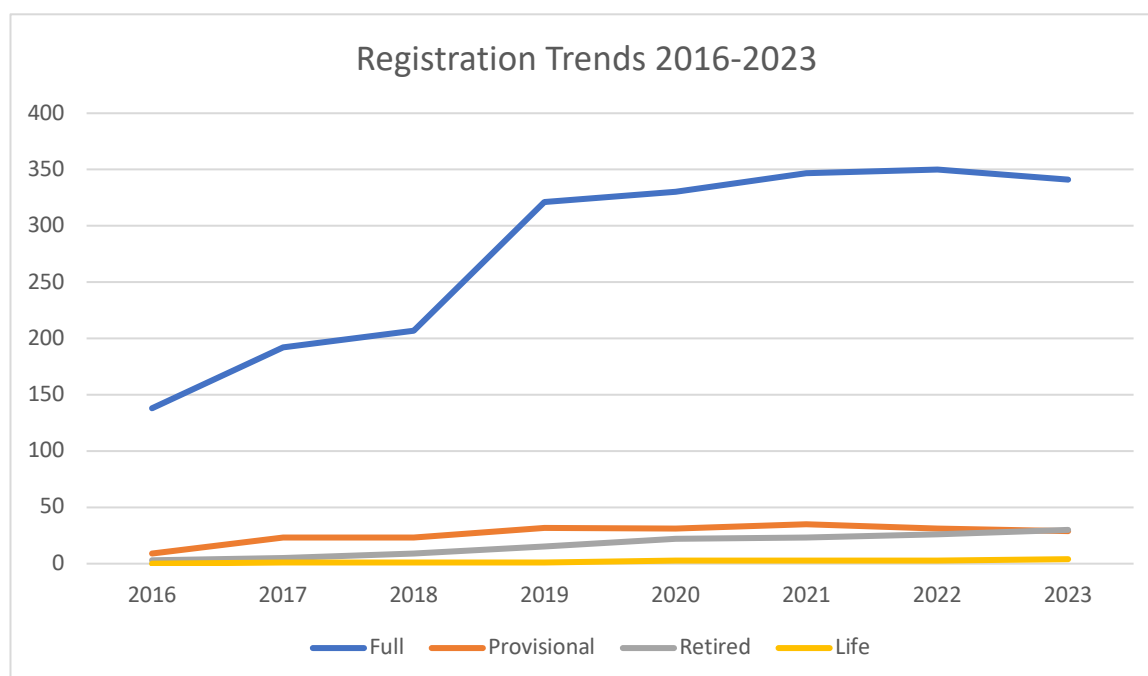

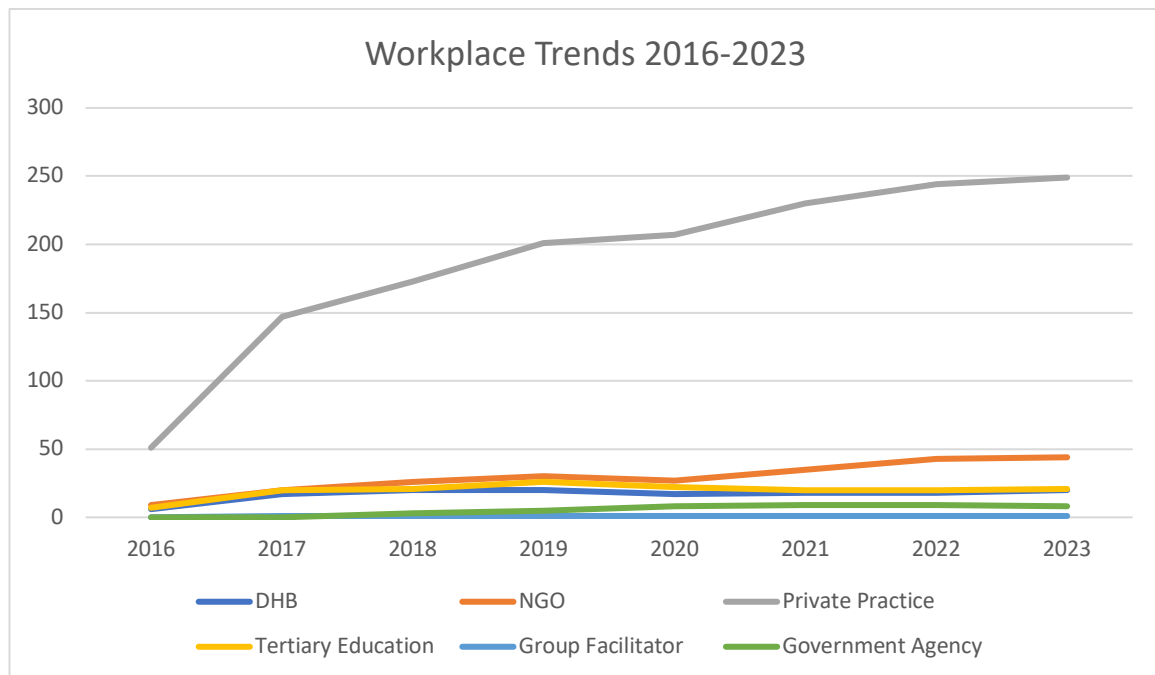

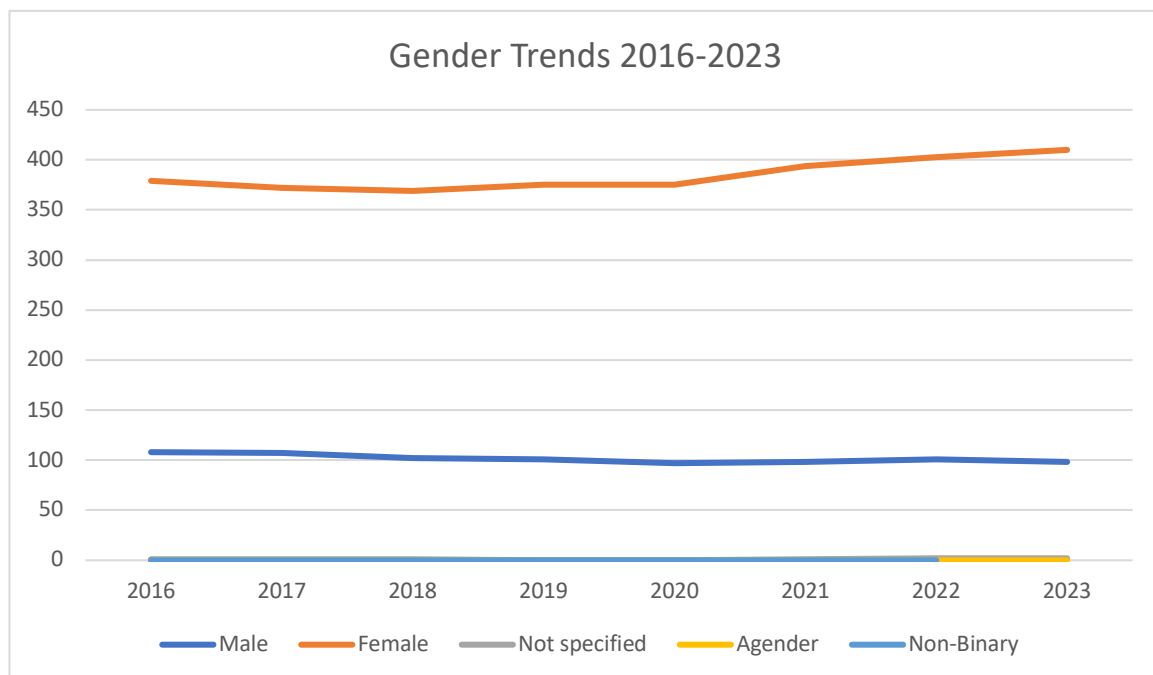

Late last year, members who did not supply their DOB were contacted and this is why there is an increase of responses from 313 in September, 2022 to 387 in March, 2023. Previously, members were not required to give this information and that is why many of those with no response are long-time members. Some wished to not disclose this information. The current application form that goes out to all prospective members has a DOB field.

If these figures are representative of the membership as a whole, most of our members are between 50 and 70 years old. With around 16% being under 50, and around 16% being over 70 years old.

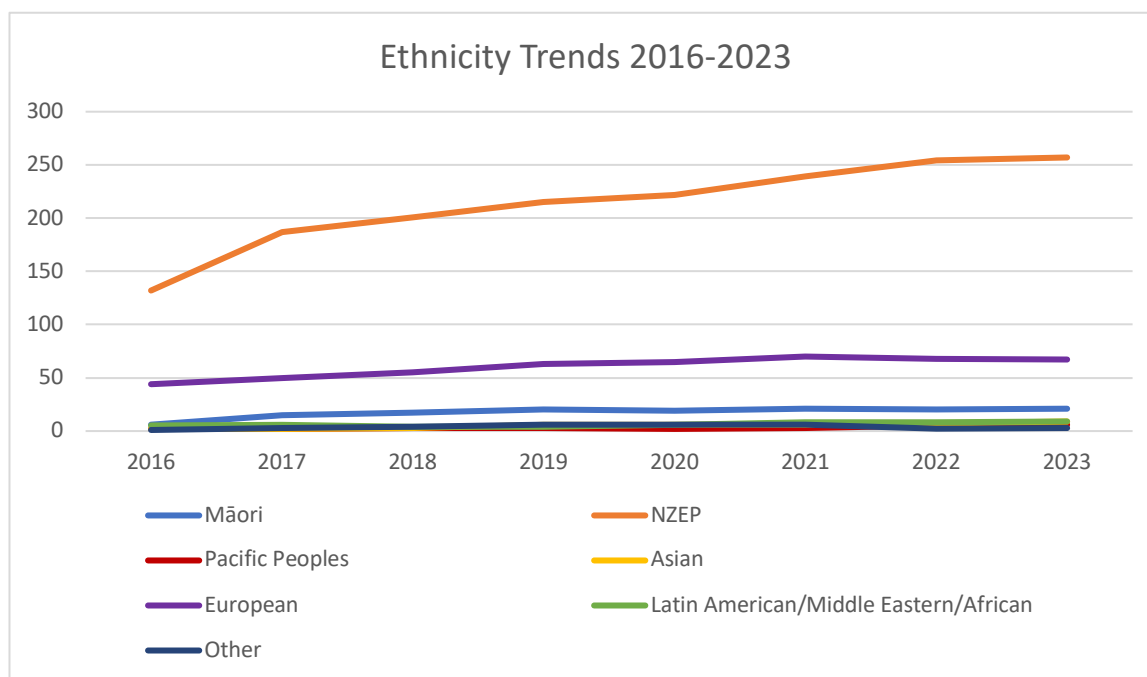
