

REPORT TO NZAP COUNCIL, APRIL 2023

From the PDC Committee

Committee membership currently stands at one confirmed member, and potentially one new member, although they have not been able to attend as no meetings have been organised; the committee has not met formally since August 2022.

There have been a few email interactions and connections with some Board members, but no official meetings as such. Predominantly this is due to the currently significantly reduced size of the committee.

There was a suggestion that the committee could be approached to assist with the planning and organising of an event planned for 2024, but given the small size of the group, it seems unlikely that the committee will be able to make much of a meaningful contribution, although it is willing to help out where it can.

The committee has previously reported to the Board that it tends to imagine a different role for itself in future, given the changing landscape post-Covid. A conversation between the NZAP president and the committee took place recently and the board is supportive of a change in its role and function in order to support the Board's future focus for professional development for members.
