

REPORT TO NZAP COUNCIL, NOVEMBER 2023

From the Administrator

Since June, the main focus in the office has been learning the new database system Membershipworks and new procedures in Wordpress to manage the database and website. While the bulk of data has been transferred from the old Wild Apricot platform there is still some information to enter into the new database and this is why some of the statistical information below is not available at this time.

We have also recently launched registrations for the 2024 conference which so far has 29 registrants.

Membership

Since June, we have had 8 people resign and 4 retire and have welcomed 17 new members, bringing our total membership to 524. This is a record number of members. We have had a large increase in student members, and have created a new category of membership entitled “Semi-Retired” as per the remit passed at the June AGM.

We have had another increase in responses in this field, possibly due to people logging into the new membership database and updating their profiles. We now have a 78% response rate in this field. If these figures are representative of the membership as a whole, most of our members are between 50 and 70 years old, with around 16% being under 50, and around 19% being over 70 years old.
