From the Administrator

The focus in the APANZ office these past few months has been the name change of the association, along with the development of the Nexus website and new APANZ website.

Membership

Since June, we have had 11 people resign, 2 retire and have welcomed 21 new members, bringing our total membership to 562 (as of 25 September 2024). This continues our record number of members. The student membership category continues to grow and remains the second largest group after Full members.
